3. Moveable parts should be securely attached.
4. Fragile items should be brought in with a display case.
5. Pairs and groups are accepted as a single item for entry and judging, as long as they are related.
6. Art accepted at the Superintendent's discretion.
7. Judges may choose to award nothing in Class Numbers where there is no competition or entry has been incorrectly entered.
