General Rules for Educational Display:

1. See Fair General Rules and Livestock General Rules for additional information.
2. Any 4-H exhibitor, a 4-H club, a group of exhibitors in one project, or the public, will be designated an area at the fair to put up an educational display. Please provide any supplies required to properly exhibit your display.
3. The exhibit will be judged on appropriate theme relating to the subject matter, artistic merit, neatness, creativity, accurate information and educational merit.
4. The exhibit must be attractive and related to Agriculture, Community Service, or Consumer Science. It should be self-explanatory so that the public would learn something by viewing the exhibit.
5. An appropriate agriculture display may include or pertain to posters, live animals, wool, unusual livestock, horse or horse equipment such as packing, shoeing or racing, breed promotional, slide shows, etc.
6. All age groups are eligible.
7. All pre-registered Exhibits must be at the fairground by 9:00 p.m., Wednesday of Fair week. Judging will be conducted Friday of fair week.
8. There is NO ENTRY FEE for animals.
