#### General Rules for Goats:

1. See Fair General Rules and Livestock General Rules for additional information.
2. All goats will be judged according to the Breed Standard for their Association.
3. **ALL GOATS MUST BE SCRAPIE TAGGED, OR SCRAPIE TAG DOCUMENTED.**
4. Milking class dairy does must be milked out at 9:00 p.m. the evening prior to judging the next day.
5. Exhibitor must wear a white shirt and white shoes. White pants are preferred but not required (black tie is not required in dairy goat). Exhibitors will not wear back tags to show goats. Animal to be shown with collar that does not detract from it and exhibitor will carry no accessories (i.e. brush, white rag, etc.) into the show ring.
6. Any goat showing signs of illness or parasites will be sent home at the discretion of the Goat and/or the Overall Livestock Superintendent.
7. All goats must be de-budded/de-horned unless breed standards state otherwise.
8. You can enter up to three (3) animals per lot number, except for market. Only one (1) animal per lot number is allowed in market class.
9. Animal must be shown in individual class in order to show in a group class.

#### Divisions:

#### **MARKET GOATS**

- a. Goat must be less than nine (9) months old.
- b. Goat must be de-budded.
- c. Goat must weigh a minimum of 40 pounds.
