General Rules for Poultry:

1. See Fair General Rules and Livestock General Rules for additional information.
2. This Department is open to poultry of any breed.
3. Animal must be owned by the exhibitor no less than 60 days before the show.
4. Exhibitor must be present and show bird during judging.
5. Any bird showing signs of illness, disease or lice/mite infestation will be removed from the building at once at the discretion of the Poultry and/or the Overall Outdoor Superintendent. All birds must be dusted at least seven days before arrival.
6. Birds must be banded before fair to ensure that there will be no mix-up in ownership.
7. Entries will be judged by the American Poultry Associations standard of perfection and the judge's discretion.
8. List Breed and Variety on entry form.
9. Use the specially marked entry form for poultry (found on Livestock Entry Form) by filling out Breed and Variety description, band number and sex; C (cock-male fowl one year or older), H (hen-female fowl one year or older), K (cockerel-male fowl under one year), P (pullet-female fowl under one year), OP (old pair-pair of fowls one year or older), YP (young pair-pair of fowls under one year)
