General Rules for Sheep:

1. See Fair General Rules and Livestock General Rules for additional information.
2. This department is open to sheep of any breed.
3. Animal must be owned by the exhibitor no less than 60 days before the show.
4. All animals, breeding and market must be scrapie tagged.
5. Market lambs may be shown in Ewes with lamb(s) if owned by same owner.

Market Lambs

- a. Lambs must be born after January 1 of the current year.
- b. Entries are limited to wether and ewe lambs.
- c. Market lambs may not be shown in breeding classes except as noted above.
- d. Animals will be judged in the following groups:
 - Lambs less than 100 lbs. will be placed in Feeder Class.
 - Lambs 155 lbs. and over will be placed in Heavyweight Class.
 - Remaining animals between the low and high weight will be placed in groups on a sliding scale.
- e. Lambs may be washed (not bleached) but must be dry by show time.
- f. Lambs must be clip sheared no more than ten (10) days prior to Show Day.
- g. Feeder Class will not be eligible to receive Grand or Reserve Grand Champion.

Exhibitor may enter up to 3 animals per lot number.

Class Numbers

Meat Type

- 31 Ram Lambs, Born after January 1 of the current year.
- 32 Ram, 1 year and under 2 years.
- 33 Ewe lambs, Born after January 1 of the current year.
- 34 Ewe, 1 year and under 2 years.
- 35 Ewe, 2 years and over. Must have lambed in the current season.
- 36 Ewe with lamb(s). Lambs must be offspring's of that ewe and born in the current season.

Wool Type

- 37 Ram Lambs, Born after January 1 of the current year.
- 38 Ram, 1 year and under 2 years.
- 39 Ewe lambs, Born after January 1 of the current year.
- 40 Ewe, 1 year and under 2 years.
- 41 Ewe, 2 years and over. Must have lambed in the current season.
- 42 Ewe with lamb(s). Lambs must be offspring's of that ewe and born in the current season.

WOOL SHOW

Class Numbers

- 45 Wool
The exhibitor must show a fleece shorn in current year.
Recommended that the fleece be placed on a sheet 5'x5' then the four corners of the sheet loosely tied in a crisscross fashion.
