**General Rules:**

1. **TWO ENTRIES PER CLASS PER EXHIBITOR. MAXIMUM 10 ENTRIES.**
2. Entries must be Original in concept and execution, the work of the exhibitor, completed within the last two years, and not entered in the previous Last Chance Stampede and Fairs.
3. Art accepted at the Superintendent's discretion.
4. "Professional" refers to anyone who derives or has derived the major source of income from selling goods or services, or teaching a skill related to the subject matter of any class in this department and should enter Professional.
5. No articles will be accepted that are made from commercially prepared kits or that are exceptionally fragile.
6. Entries must be appropriately framed, with glass or Plexiglas over watercolors, pastels and drawings. EACH FRAME MUST BE EQUIPPED WITH SCREW EYES AND WIRE FOR HANGING. Maximum size: 48" x 48" including frame. Not to exceed 35 pounds.
7. Pairs and groups are accepted as a single item for entry and judging, as long as they are related.
8. Judging will be by qualified judges of the fine arts. The option is reserved to withhold ribbons and awards in a class where there is no deserving entry.
9. Prints may not be photo-mechanically reproduced.

## What the Judges Look For:

**General Appearance:** Neat, clean, finishing techniques suitable to subject & medium

**Workmanship:** Techniques correct & consistent, composition balanced

**Creativity & Suitability:** Originality or presentation of subject choice of color combinations, medium & techniques suitable to subject, difficulty of project

4. Entries with moveable parts should be securely attached.
5. Fragile items should be brought in their own display case.
6. Related pairs and groups are accepted as a single item for entry and judging.
7. Judges may choose to award nothing in Class Numbers where there is no competition or entry has been incorrectly entered.
